\*Daimaruyu is an abbreviation for Otemachi, Marunouchi and Yurakucho

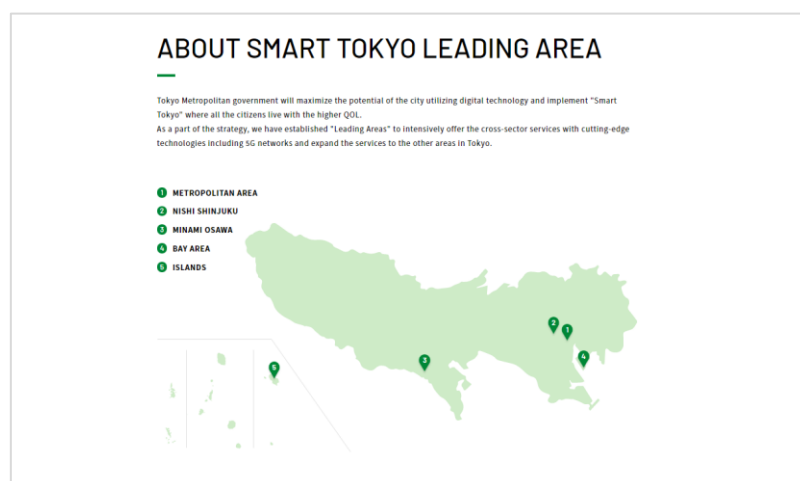


Image: (2) Leading area overview
